These terms apply to the video recording of your talk produced by us (DKUUG Video committee), and set out the intellectual property rights you grant to us in the contributed materials. If this contribution is on behalf of a company, the term 'you' will also mean the company you identify below. If you agree to be bound by these terms, fill in the information requested below and provide your signature.

Read this agreement carefully before signing.

1. With respect to any worldwide copyrights, or copyright applications and registrations, in the recordings:
 - we hereby assign to you full ownership, and to the extent that such assignment is or becomes invalid, ineffective or unenforceable, we hereby grant to you a perpetual, irrevocable, non-exclusive, worldwide, no-charge, royalty-free, unrestricted license to exercise all rights under those copyrights. **This includes, at your option, the right to sublicense these same rights to third parties through multiple levels of sublicensees or other licensing arrangements;**
 - however the recordings shall at anytime after recording be made available under a suitable CC (Creative Commons), FSF (Free Software Foundation) or OSI (Open Source Initiative) approved license;
 - You hereby gives us permission to publish the recordings of your talk on our website, and mirrors, under the below specified license and that you will keep our and others attribution, in any derivative work even if you are allowed to do so by the license you choose to let us release the recordings under;
